What is the Think Pharmacy Minor Ailments Service?

The Minor Ailments Service makes it easy for you and your family to get advice and treatment for your health concerns at a time that suits you.



How does it work?

- You can visit any pharmacy without an appointment for advice and treatment.
- Your consultation will always be confidential with a qualified pharmacist in a private room.
- Consultations are always free, regardless of whether the pharmacist provides you with any treatment.
- The pharmacist can supply some medicines to you that normally would need a prescription, without you having to see your doctor first.

What does the service offer?

You will be able to get advice and treatment (if you need it) on: Eye infections, hay fever, head lice, migraine, oral thrush (in babies), constipation, diarrhoea, indigestion, heartburn, piles, threadworms, cystitis, thrush, rashes, impetigo, scabies, acne, athlete's foot and gout.

How much does it cost?

As this is an NHS service, the consultation is free. If the pharmacist agrees that you need medicines they will be provided free of charge for people who get free prescriptions, and for no more than the prescription charge if you have to pay.
